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CARE & MAINTENANCE OF BATHROOM SANITARY WARES, FITTINGS & ACCESSORIES

Tap fittings & accessories

Maintain regular cleaning for bathroom fittings & accessories will prolong the chrome finished.

Please wipe and clean the accessories and tap fittings with normal soap and water. Any cleaning products residue left on the fittings & accessories MUST rinse or wipe off immediately.

When cleaning basin mixer, watch out for water that might flow into hole* behind the basin mixer and damage the cabinet, please check the cabinet regularly. *(the hole meant for rod to control pop-up waste)

Do not use acids or any abrasives cleaning products, which will destroy and tarnish the surface.

Shower hose is designated for showering, not for any other purposes. Do not pull the shower hose, please use a separate rubber hose for washing inside the bathroom, if necessary.

Water Closets (Toilet Bowl) & Washbasins & Kitchen Sinks

Do not throw hard objects or any other unwanted waste, which not supposed to be thrown into toilet bowl, as it will choke the toilet bowl.

Do not put any sanitizer neither in tablets-form or liquid-form inside the cistern / tank, these sanitizers will deform the rubber or silicone underneath the discharge valve and caused the water flowing non-stop into toilet bowl.

Do not pour any chemical or any abrasives cleaning products into washbasin and toilet bowl, these products will corrode any rubber at washbasins, bottle trap and pan collar (joint between toilet bowl and floor or wall). Please rinse or flush them immediately.

Do not force "down" (close) the seat & cover, "forcing" it down might damage soft-close mechanism and possible crack the seat & cover. Always, let it close by itself or press it down gently.

Washbasin installed on wooden cabinet must be checked frequently for water seepage or dripping to avoid damages to the cabinets.

IMPORTANT: ACIDS CAN NOT BE USED AT ALL TIMES.
